For the attention of the City Council of Vienna

Demand for equal allocation of funding for all full-day schools in Vienna.

From the beginning of the 2020/21 school year 70 full-day primary schools (GTVS) were made available to families free of charge. However, open primary schools (OVS) can still cost up to 2.500 Euro per child per school year.

Currently 6 out of 10 families in Vienna do not benefit from the removal of afternoon care and catering costs.

This is unjust and we are not prepared to accept it.

We have already approached the SPÖ, who are responsible for the funding allocation. However, neither the mayor, Dr. Michael Ludwig nor Jürgen Czernohorszky, City Councilor for Education saw a need for action on this matter.

We subsequently contacted the Ombudsman who examined the situation and found us to be correct. We will therefore further pursue this matter.

Only when afternoon care is equally affordable in every school can families chose the optimal arrangement for their needs.

We demand;

- ~ childcare until 3.30 free of charge.
- ~ lunches provided in the school free of charge
- ~ equal funding allocation for every type of school.
